

Templeton Elementary School Building Project

Land:

Senator Brewer worked with us over the past year to create legislation that would allow for the town of Templeton to obtain free land from the state for the purpose of building an elementary school.

The 15.6 acre parcel of land is located on Crows Hill which is on Route 202 about 1/3 mile east of the intersection of Hill Road and US Route 202.

There is a conceptual design that was developed by the state to ensure that it would be possible to build a school on that site. (Attached)

Massachusetts School Building Authority (MSBA):

We are working with the state to design and build the school because we will receive a minimum of 60% reimbursement. Our project has been on hold as we searched for land. Now that the land has been obtained we can restart the feasibility study.

Our Owners Project Manager (OPM) has been working with us to secure the designer who will be completing the feasibility study. In addition, the OPM has worked to make the feasibility study can be completed with the money that was voted for this purpose.

The feasibility project is on track to be submitted to the MSBA in June of 2014. It will take a few months to know what direction we will be going once the work is submitted to MCBA. There are two options, build new construction or build model school. There is a process that must be followed to determine our direction.
